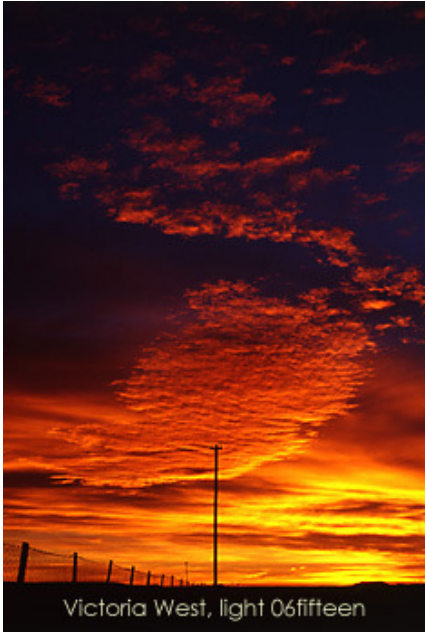


To all photographers producing or wanting to start Audio-Visual !
