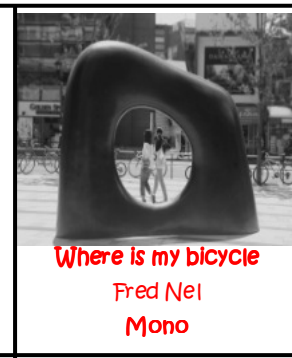

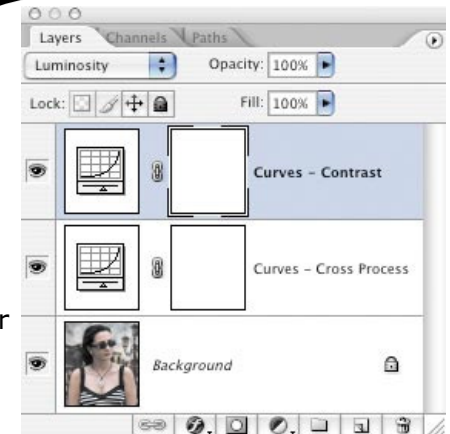

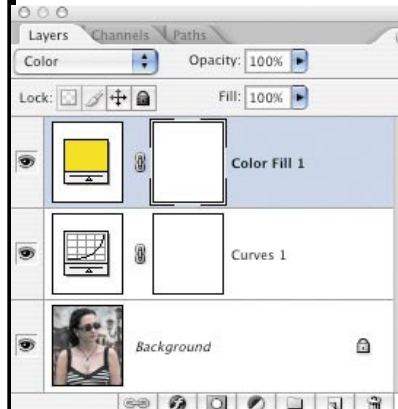
# Cross Processing

## STEP 6

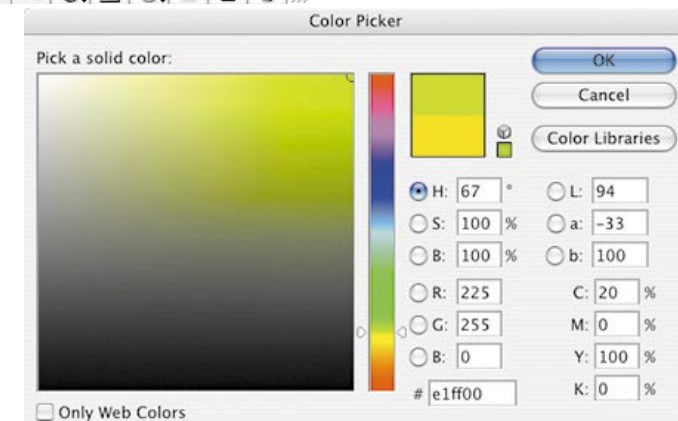
If you need to fine-tune the image contrast, add a Curves adjustment layer and set its blending mode to Luminosity so it doesn't cause any further color shifts.



## STEP 7



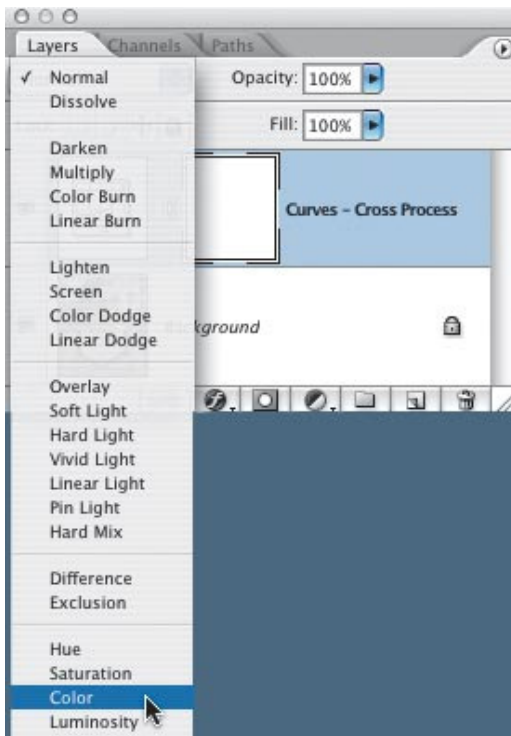
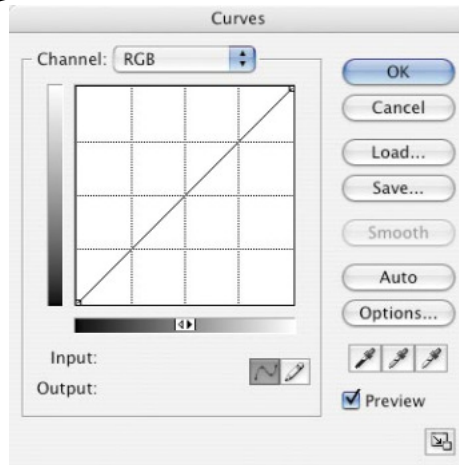
Another optional final step is to add a yellow color cast to the picture. In the Layers palette, click the "Create new fill or new adjustment layer" icon and choose Solid Color. Select a yellow-green and click OK, then reduce the new layer's opacity – 10% is as much as you'll need.



# Cross Processing

## STEP 4

Fine-tune the channel curves to suit your image, but leave the combined RGB curve untouched. Focus on the color balance rather than the contrast, which you can fix later, in step 6.



## STEP 5

Blown highlights are a common — if not always welcome — characteristic of C-41 as E-6 cross-processing. They should result from the contrast-increasing curves used in steps 1-3, but in Photoshop it's possible to eliminate them if you wish. Try changing the Curves adjustment layer's blending mode to Color and the image will combine the color shifts with the image's original luminos-

- Vat jou 3-poot! Ja, ek weet jy beplan nie noodwendig om in die donker af te neem nie maar vat hom saam. Ja, ek weet hy is swaar om te dra maar vat hom saam. Ja ek weet . . . vat net die ding saam!! As jy vlieg, pak hom verkieslik in jou bagasie – sommige lugrederye laat jou nie toe om hom as handbagasie te neem nie – veral as jy internasionaal vlieg (hulle sien dit seker as ‘n tradisionele wapen . . .) Ouma het vir my ‘n sak vir myne gemaak – een met ‘n handvatsel groot genoeg dat ek hom ook oor my skouer kan gooi. Dit werk nogal vir my. Ek ontkoppel my 3-poot dat hy in my tas kan pas en vat die sak in my bagasie saam – by my eindbestemming koppel ek als en dra die sak gemaklik. In Brugge moes ek my 3-poot op my fiets vervoer en ek was baie dankbaar dat ek my sak saamgebring het.
- Vat ‘n lappie saam om jou lens af te vee! Ek het by my oogkundige ‘n paar ekstra lappies gebedel om my bril skoon te maak en hulle werk wonderlik om my filters af te vee. Maak nie saak of jy in die Kalahari of by Umlanga is nie – die stof en sneeu en seelug en motreen en en en gaan op jou filter saampak en jou spesiale foto gaan bederf wees as jy nie so ‘n lappie byderhand het nie. “Byderhand” is natuurlik die wagwoord hier – dit help nie jy los hom in die hotelkamer nie – dra hom by jou!
- Stel jou kamera se tyd! As jy op ‘n plek gaan vakansie hou wat in ‘n ander tydsone val, stel jou kamera se tyd na die plaaslike tyd. Ek vergeet gewoonlik om dit te doen en is elke keer vies vir myself as ek wil teruggaan om te sien hoe laat ek ‘n sekere foto geneem het.

## Cont..

Maak 'n back-up van jou backup! Mens kry klein, ligte 'laptops' en allerhande ander 'gadets' waarop jy jou foto's kan aflaai en backup. My redes daarvoor is die volgende: Moenie dink jou kaarte gaan groot genoeg wees nie – hulle is gewoonlik nie! Die risiko om als net op jou kamera kaarte te hou is net te groot – as jou kaart iets oorkom of wegraak is al jou spesiale oomblikke daarmee heen! As jy baie foto's neem gaan jy later by die huis nie meer weet wat is wat nie (ek weet jy dink jy gaan as onthou maar jy gaan nie). Ek laai elke dag my foto's af in 'n folder met die dag se datum of plek of naam op. Soms skep ek meer as een folder vir 'n dag se aktiwiteite – hang af hoeveel het ek gedoen - en ek nommer elke folder. Aan die einde van die vakansie is alles reeds georden en ek weet waar om 'n foto te gaan soek oor 3 jaar. Cornel het onlangs AL haar spesiale foto's verloor wat op 'n ekstreme hardeskyf gebêre was. Maak 'n back-up van jou back-up!

- Pak versigtig! As jy gaan vlieg, pak sover moontlik al jou kosbare toerusting in jou handbagasie. My UV filter wat binne 'n beskermde omhulsel was het al binne my tas gebreek – wees versigtig! Jy weet ook nie of jy jou tas aan die ander kant gaan sien nie, so vir veiligheid, pak eerder jou boek in jou tas en hou jou kamera goed by jou . . .

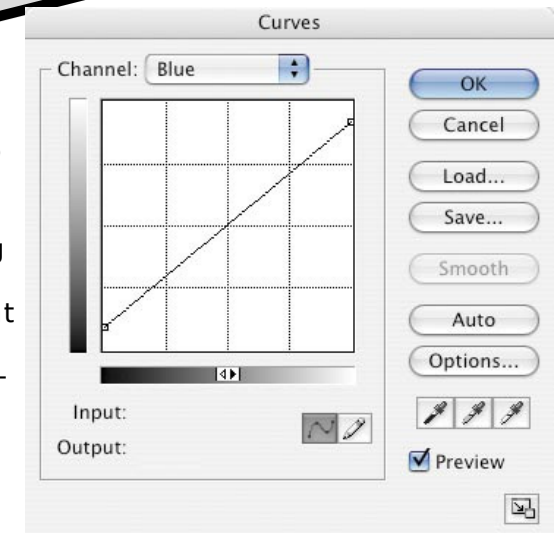

## Cross Processing

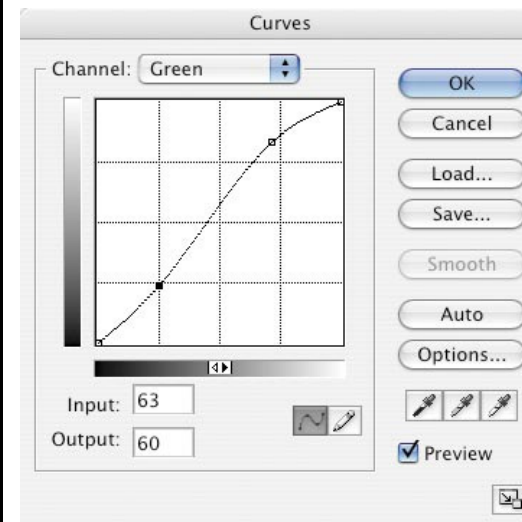
### TIP

To save your curve to a file on your hard drive, just click the Save button. Applying the same cross-processing adjustment to other images is a simple matter of loading it with the Load button in the Curves dialog box.



### STEP 2

Select the Blue channel and drag the curve's top-right point downward. It doesn't need to be much – just enough to take some blue out of the highlights. Then drag the curve's bottom-right point up a little, blocking up the Blue channel in the shadows.



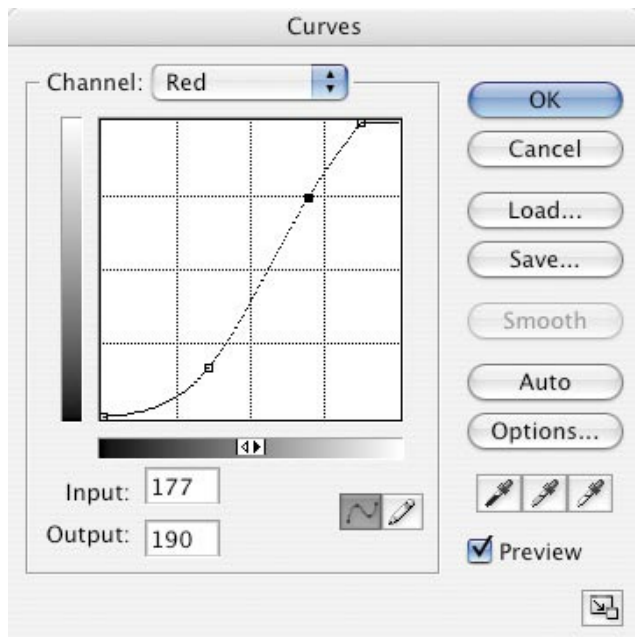
### STEP 3

In the Green channel, add another gentle S curve – increasing the contrast, especially in the highlights.

## Cross Processing

### STEP 1

With the original image open, click the "Create new fill or new adjustment layer" icon in the Layers palette and select Curves. From the Channel drop-down box, select the Red channel and drag the top right of the curve a little to the left. Then drag a couple of points on the curve so that it forms a very gentle S — darkening the shadows and brightening the Red channel's highlights.

## Lomography

### 5. Approach the object of your Lomographic desire as close as possible

Get close - click - from the wrist looking deep into the eyes, full frontal, close up and precisely whatever it is that interests you. Laughing as you go, feeling good so that everyone can see that Lomography is the most obvious and natural thing in the world.

### 6. Don't Think (William Firebrace)

Put your head in the ice cold bathtub, hold your breath, count to 100 and let your troubles dissolve. Then jerk your head out again and with it firmly on your shoulders, grab your camera and hit the streets. Start snapping away, live it and have fun.

### 7. Be Fast

A mere tenth of a second makes the difference between Lomography and not Lomography. Don't waste time with (Just don't wait any time) settings or adjustments, thinking about it, faffing around and procrastinating. First impressions have a quality of their own, trust yourself.

### 8. You don't have to know beforehand what is captured on the film

Give the randomness of Lomography a chance. Enjoy your new way of living with random occurrence. You're not here for Lomography! Lomography is here for you! Lomography only works if the only thing you concentrate on is celebrating your life.

## Lomography

### What the Hell is Lomography

In the early 1990's we, at that time students in Vienna, Austria, discovered a small enigmatic Russian camera; the Lomo Kompakt Automat. Together we started a new style of artistic experimental photography with our first unorthodox snapshot caravots. Our approach: taking as many photographs (Lomographs) as possible in the most impossible of situations and from the most unusual of positions possible, and then having them developed as cheaply as possible. The result was a flood of authentic, colourful, crazy, off-the-wall and unfamiliar snapshots, shot by many people and mounted on panels to form a sea of thousands of Lomographs; the LomoWalls.



# Lomography

Exhibitions, interactive projects, events and live visuals held and performed all over the world with millions of Lomographic snapshots have been the most significant forms of Lomographic communication since the beginning. The images, provided by tens of thousands of Lomographic amateurs, combined with the space, the exhibition architecture, the interactive programme and the international communication have become the hallmark of Lomographic projects. The presentations are held in galleries, museums, people's homes, clubs, bars, shops, abandoned buildings, planetariums, factories or stations, and are accompanied by programmes of photo competitions and events with special visual and music performances (major shows have been held in Moscow, New York, Vienna, Berlin, St. Petersburg, Seoul, Havana, Zurich, Cologne, Madrid, Cairo, Frankfurt, Dubai, Oslo, Tokyo, Hong Kong, Singapore, Buenos Aires, Beijing, London and many other cities, where up to 100,000 Lomographic images were displayed at a time).

What started out spontaneously as an artistic approach to photography in the Vienna underground scene soon developed into an international socio-cultural movement, using photography as a creative approach to communicating, absorbing and capturing the world. Today we are a globally active organization dedicated to experimental and creative snapshot photography.



# Lomography

## The Ten Golden Rules of Lomography

### 1. Take your camera everywhere you go

In bed, in Gorki park, in a propeller driven airplane or in the launderette: You grab your camera and everything around you starts to vibrate with life, be prepared, keep your camera close at hand and ready for action everywhere and all the time.

### 2. Use it anytime: Day or Night

Every single second has its own unique, light, grey, colourful, woolly, profound, or flat mood. Your life is not going to wait for your camera, its rules and the floating around involved in it. Either - click - and you have captured the situation as it is, or you haven't.

### 3. Lomography is not interference in your life but part of it

Lomography doesn't interrupt the direction in which your life is going; rather it's a significant and integral part of it. Just like talking, walking, sleeping, eating, thinking, drinking, laughing and loving, Lomography is a colourful sign that you are alive.

### 4. Shoot from the hip

It is as simple as it is unusual: You don't have to look through the viewfinder to take a good picture, no, on the contrary! Give yourself more freedom in your choice of perspectives. Hang it up in the air, out in front or behind your back. No limits - just your experience mixed with some luck.
